Speculate

To guess possible answers to a question when you do not have enough information to know the answer.

Subsequent

Something that happens after something else.

Grove

A group of trees planted closely together.

Fringe

The outer part of an area or something that exists on the edges.

Assemblage Theory

A theory used in philosophy to help understand how complex things; such as social networks, physical objects, biological matter, are made by individual parts that remain autonomous within the whole.

Écriture Féminine

Introduced by Helene Cixous in her essay, The Laugh of the Medusa, Écriture Féminine refers to a uniquely feminine style of writing characterised by disruptions in the text, such as gaps, silences, puns, new images and so on.

Bricolage

The act of constructing or creating something from a different and an easily available range of things.
